Indeterminate Offenders/Parole

INTRODUCTION

Offenders with offense dates before July 1, 1984 and crimes punishable by imprisonment are sentenced to indeterminate terms. Parole decisions are made by the Indeterminate Sentence Review Board.

Offenders with offense dates on or after July 1, 1984 were given determinate sentences. These sentences, referred to as Sentencing Reform Act (SRA) sentences, are based on a theory of proportionality, equality and justice where similar times are imposed for similar crimes. There is no oversight body making decisions about the releasability of offenders with determinate sentences.

Certain sex offenders, who commit their crimes on or after September 1, 2001, are given Determinate-Plus (CCB) sentences. A minimum term of prison confinement is set by the court at the time of sentencing. The maximum term is that statutory maximum for the specific offense. Decisions related to the releaseability to community custody of CCB offenders who have served the minimum term, are also made by the Indeterminate Sentence Review Board.

This report contains data related to offenders who are currently serving PRE-SRA indeterminate sentences. A companion report related to determinate-plus/CCB sentenced offenders is also compiled by the Indeterminate Sentence Review Board.
